# **CHILD NOTES: Elmer Foster NAY**

**General:** Foster went by his second name during his lifetime. He worked as a stone mason, usually along side his father, Elmer Carr Nay. The family pictures show him at work on a job, building the school at Joseph, Sevier Co., UT. The family knew him to be a kind person, liked to kid with the yourger brothers and sister. He was known to be a close pal to his sister, Delia. He often would send a small notes, postcards or letters to his family in Monroe, while away from home. Foster never married. Later in his life, he went to Sugar City, Idaho to work in a sugar factory. While lifting a large bag, he ruptered his bowel, which sent him to the hospital. They soon discovered he needed to be sent to the LDS hospital in Salt Lake City. His Mother, Charlotte Jane Nay, traveled there to be with him. He died there, after surgery, and was brought home to be buried in the Monroe City Cemetery.
